Current Affairs of Rajasthan - July Month

1. Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy College
 - a. Rajasthan Government gave the approval to establish the 6 Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy College in the state.
 - i. Integrated Colleges → Jaipur, Kota, Sikar, Bikaner and Bharatpur
 - ii. Government college of Yoga & Naturopathy → Udaipur
2. Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Governance and Social Science
 - a. Starts from 2nd October at Kanak Bhawan, Central Park(Jaipur)
 - b. Aim:
 - i. To prepare the youth to play a role in social work while imbibing the teachings of the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi.
 - c. Institute started in the lines of Tata Institute of Social Science and Maharashtra Institute of Technology School of Governance Pune.
 - d. Committee has been constituted for giving shape to the plan of the institution under the Chairmanship of Dr. Dev Swarup, Vice Chancellor of Law University.
3. "OIL INDIA" got access to Explore Crude Oil and Natural Gas in the Bikaner, Jaisalmer and Jodhpur regions from the Union Ministry of Petroleum and Gas for 4 years.
4. PM Awas Yojana Gramin (PMAY - G)
 - a. Rajasthan got first position in PMAY-G for the year 2021 ranking.
 - b. Out of 33 districts of Rajasthan, 31 comes among the top 100 districts of the country.
 - c. Only two districts are not in the top 100 districts of the country. They are
 - i. Tonk(109 rank)
 - ii. Sirohi(156 rank)
 - d. Top Rank's district of Rajasthan
 - i. Dungarpur(2nd)
 - ii. Nagaur(3rd)
 - iii. Bharatpur(5th)

5. Elets world Education Leader of the year Award
 - a. Education minister Govind singh Todasar was awarded with this Award for excellent management of various innovations made in the field of education in Rajasthan during the Corona Pandemic.

6. Nehru Child Protection Award
 - a. The Rajasthan government presents the Award to those who have done remarkable work in the field of child protection.

7. Protection Cell for Transgender Rights:
 - a. Rajasthan Government on June 24, decided to constitute a Transgender Protection Cell under the Protection of Rights of Transgenders Act, 2019, in the state and has approved the proposal of Finance department in this regard.
 - b. The state government's step comes in the light of discrimination and atrocity faced by the community.
 - c. The protection cell will work directly from the office of the Director-General of Police and prevent crimes against the people.
 - i. The department will be a team of six people, including a police inspector, a sub-inspector, two constables, a counsellor or psychological counsellor and a data entry operator.

8. Rajiv Gandhi Lift Nahar Phase-3 project
 - a. Objective:
 - i. Providing drinking water to 76.47 lakh people including the population of Jodhpur city, five other towns and 2,104 villages
 - ii. It is also proposed to meet the industrial requirements of water in the proposed Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor(DMIC), Rohat district in Pali ad RIICO are in Jodhpur
 - iii. According to the project, water will be brought from Indira Gandhi Main Canal to Jodhpur with the help of 4 pumping stations through a 205 km pipeline parallel to the existing open canal.
 - b. The project was earlier proposed to be funded by the Japanese International Cooperation Agency(JICA), but now the state government grants all funds to the project.
 - i. JAICA (not funding in this project)

9. Chief Minister Corona Child Welfare Scheme
 - a. Objective:

- i. Upbringing of the children orphaned due to Corona epidemic, under which the state government will bear the cost of education.
- ii. The government will give Rs 2,500 per month to the child till he/she turns 18 as well as financial aid of Rs 5 lakh post turning 18.
- iii. The government will also provide free education to the orphaned children till Class 12.
- iv. Apart from financial aid, girls studying in colleges will get hostel facility on priority basis while boys will be given incentives
- v. Note:
 1. Government is also taking many steps for financial help for women who are widowed due to Corona.

10. Ramgarh Vishdhari WS

- a. Located in Bundi District.
- b. Area: 1,052.12 sq. km
- c. In 2019, the forest department was deliberating on upgrading the sanctuary to a tiger reserve.
 - i. The state government advised declaring the sanctuary by the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) for final approval.
 - ii. NTCA:
 1. The National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) was established in December 2005 following a Tiger Task Force recommendation, constituted by India's prime minister for reorganising Project Tiger and the many Tiger Reserves in India.
 - iii. News:
 1. NTCA gave the approval on 21 June, 2021 to make Ramgarh Vishdhari WS to be a Tiger Reserve.
 2. On July 5, the Union ministry of environment, forest and climate change approved the recommendation of NTCA and made Ramgarh Vishdhari WS be India's 52nd tiger sanctuary.
 3. Now, Ramgarh Vishdhari WS:
 - a. 4th Tiger reserve of Rajasthan and 52nd Tiger Reserve of India.
 - b. It can house 35 tigers.
 - iv. Note:

12. Ambedkar DBT Voucher Yojana

Applicable



- a. Students studying in all the undergraduate and postgraduate government colleges run by the Social Justice and Empowerment Department at the district headquarters, who stay away from home and study by renting a room at other places.
- b. 2000 per month will be given under Ambedkar DBT voucher scheme as a recharge amount for accommodation, food and electricity-water etc. for those students.
- c. The operation of this scheme is being started for the students studying in the academic session 2021-22.
- d. The benefit of the scheme will be available to the regular students of SC, ST, OBC, MBC, EWS.
 - i. Benefits will be given to 1500 students of Scheduled Castes, 1500 of Scheduled Tribes, 1500 of Other Backward Classes, 750 of Most Backward Classes, 750 of Economically Backward Classes. The last date for application form is 15th September.

13. IMC Digital Technology IT Awards - 2020

- a. Rajasthan "IT & Communication department" got two award for
 - i. Best project in the country within the end user organization government award
 - ii. End user Category - Government Award

14. Nanhey Hath Kalam Ke sath programme

- a. On the occasion of International Child Labor Prohibition Day(12 June 2021), 'Covid-19 Child Labor Violence Free Childhood Public Awareness Campaign' was launched with 'Nanhe Haath Kalam' on Saturday.
- b. This campaign will be run in Jaipur district under the joint aegis of Labor Department, UNICEF and NGO Pink City Cycle Rickshaw Driver Association.
- c. Under the campaign, public awareness work will be done for the eradication of child labor in small and remote villages of Jaipur district for 6 consecutive months. Under this, efforts will be made to motivate the children who have lost their parents or relatives due to the Covid epidemic, so that they do not turn away from education.
- d. Along with this, to provide these children the benefits of welfare schemes of the state government, Survey for special schools for child labor children and work will be done to create an education environment for children of migrant labour.

15. Ba-Bapu Plantation Plan

- a. Under this scheme
 - i. Nursery development, nutrition garden and plantation work will be done from **July 5 to September 11** under NREGA convergence.
 - ii. 1 crore saplings will be planted by Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Department.

 - i. Iron molds, iron pipes, Iron flakes, molten pieces of iron, various types of iron pieces have been found. Also, the wall of bricks can be of a well.

20. Mukhyamantri Anupriti coaching Scheme

- a. Inaugurated: 5th June 2021
- b. Department: Social Justice Empowerment Department and the Minority Affairs Department.
- c. Economically weaker students of every category will get equal opportunities to move forward. Any student will get the benefit of this scheme for a period of 1 year only. Every year 10 thousand talented students will get benefit from Anuprati Coaching Scheme in Rajasthan
- d. Eligibility:
 - i. Students annual family income is less than Rs. 8 lakh per annum.
 - ii. Students whose parents are drawing salary up to Pay Matrix Level-11 as state Government Personnel will also be eligible for the scheme.

21. Jal Jeevan Mission

- a. Present Rajasthan government has assured that tap water supply under Jal Jeevan Mission, to every household in Rajasthan will be provided by 2024.
- b. JJM will be implemented in the State in mission-mode, ensuring 'no one is left out' with focus on sustainable sources for assured tap water supply on a long term basis.
